Thinking about gender roles



- This resource requires pupils to consider various gender identities and roles. Using the framework of a Venn diagram, pupils are asked to separate adjectives, jobs, domestic duties and childcare responsibilities into female, male and gender-neutral sets. Pupils should then think critically about their choices and reflect on different scenarios.
- The words/statements provided are to be used as a guide. We encourage you to adapt these if you wish.

Choose one of the four word-sort activities a) Adjectives b) Jobs c) Domestic roles d) Childcare

- 1. Ask pupils individually / in pairs / in groups to cut and place the words / statements on the Venn diagram according to whether they perceive the word / statement to be Female, Male or All genders.
- 2. How did they decide? What sort of discussion was there? Where do their ideas about how to decide come from? (N.B. With c & d they are very likely to be influenced by what happens in their family, so there will be issues if e.g. there are single parents. What if e.g. one of the parents goes out to work or both go out to work?)




- 3. Would their answers look different if the activity was done:
- a) in the period their grandparents were children?
- b) at the time their parents were children?
- c) by a child in 20 years time?
- 4. What has this activity taught you about gender roles and their perceptions? How are the roles of men and women changing? How would you like them to be?

Notes to Teacher:

- *To make sure that the activity runs effectively, it is helpful agree on some ground-rules. For example:
- a) Listen actively respect others when they are talking.
- b) Do not be afraid to respectfully challenge one another by asking questions, but refrain from personal attacks.
- *Try not to influence pupils.
- *Remember that all families are different. Try not to make assumptions.
